

PCSC Dyslexia Data

Mandates did not require tracking of dyslexia information during the 2018-2019 school year. Therefore,

*the number of students identified as “at risk” or “at some risk” for dyslexia during the 2018-2019 school year is zero.

*the number of students who received specific dyslexia intervention during the 2018-2019 school year is zero.

PCSC will track this data during the 2019-2020 school year and beyond. This data will be made available on the corporation website and the school's reading plan each year hereafter. Beginning the 2019-2020 school year PCSC has a plan in place to track this data and report on its findings. PCSC's dyslexia intervention program will be available for review on the corporation's website. Each academic year, PCSC will continue to report the intervention program used, number of students who received dyslexia intervention(s), as well as the total number of students identified with dyslexia during the prior school year.
